

Direct Access from Narita International Airport to Sendai:

- Domestic airlines from Narita International Airport to Sendai Airport: <u>ANA</u> airlines (60 min)
- Railway from Sendai Airport to JR Sendai Station: <u>Sendai Airport Access Line</u> (17 min by rapid train, or 25 min by local train). JPY 630.

Access from Narita or Haneda International Airport via Tokyo Station to Sendai:

- Railway from Narita International Airport to Tokyo Station: <u>JR Narita Express (N'EX)</u> with all reserved seating (53-59 min). JPY 2,940.
- Railway from Haneda International Airport to Tokyo Station: <u>Tokyo Monorail</u> from Haneda Airport International Terminal to Monorail Hamamatsucho (19 min). JPY 470. Transfer to <u>JR Yamanote Line</u> or JR Keihin-Tohoku/ Negishi Line at <u>JR Hamamatsucho Station</u> to Tokyo. JPY 150. See <u>Tokyo Metropolitan area railway map</u>.
- Railway from Tokyo to Sendai: JR Hayate or Hayabusa <u>Tohoku Shinkansen</u> Superexpress with all reserved seating (96-101 min). JPY 10,790. Unreserved seating is available for Yamabiko Tohoku Shinkansen trains, which take 20-40 minutes longer. See <u>JR Map and timetables</u>.

[Where to buy train tickets] At Ticket Office/Travel Service Center of Narita Airport station, JR Ticket Offices (Midori-no-madoguchi), Travel Service Centers (View Plaza) or reserved seat ticket machines, you can buy a ticket from Narita to Sendai. Also at Hamamatsucho, you can buy a ticket from Hamamatsucho via Tokyo to Sendai. For your Shinkansen seat reservation, please consult the ticket office at Tokyo station.

Overseas visitors can also buy <u>JR East Pass</u> (JPY 20,000 for a 5-day Pass) online or at JR Narita Airport International Station's Travel Service Centers (View Plaza).
